- ✓ A vital disciple is truly a joyful, responsive, visionary and fruitful Christian.

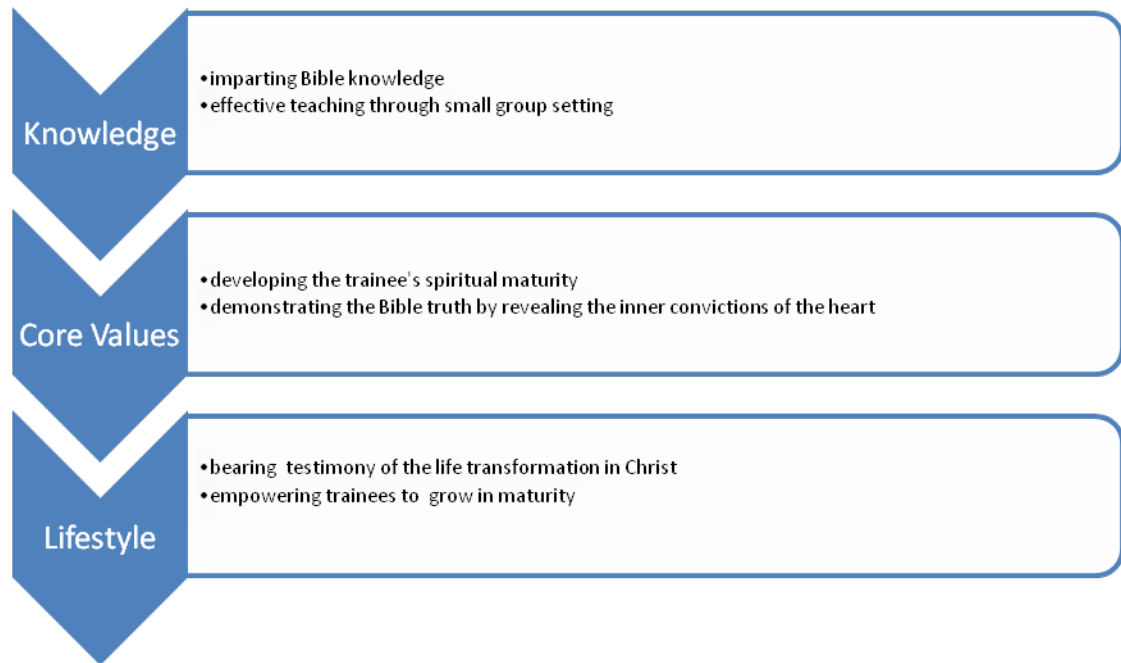
### Ministry Philosophy:

- ✓ Jesus Christ impacts his own disciples by spending time in nurturing and mentoring them.
- ✓ Teaching is not static but dynamic. Teachers are mentors catching on life moments to impart knowledge and life-convicting truth to the disciples.
- ✓ Holy habits develop Christian maturity in the journey of sanctification.
- ✓ New believers need to grow out of the erratic perks of growth become mature believers of Jesus Christ.
- ✓ The life-changing Christians are the main attraction to seekers.

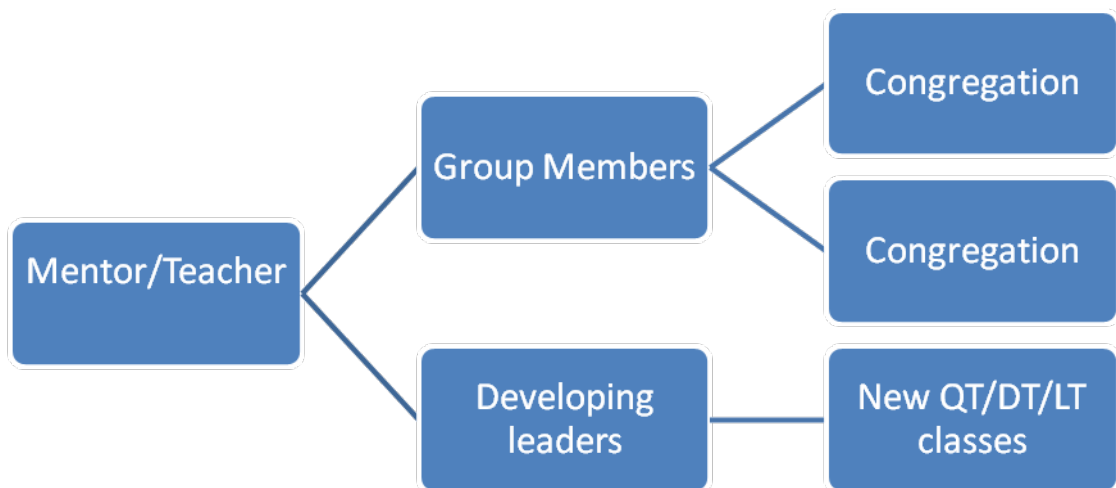

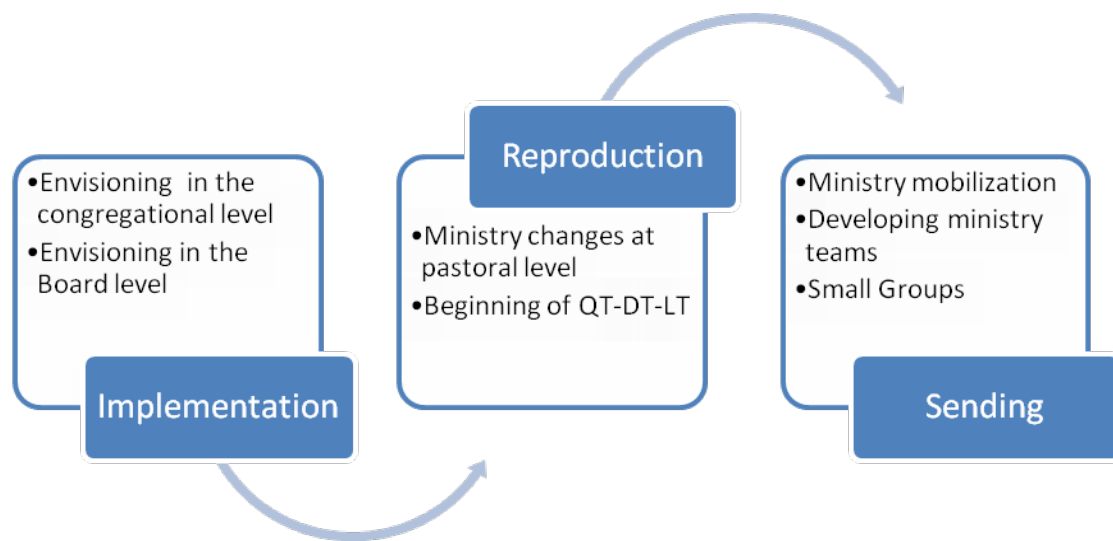
### Role of a mentor
